The national Native elder needs assessment survey: *Identifying Our Needs: A Survey of Elders III*, developed by the National Resource Center on Native American Aging (NRCNAA) with assistance from the AK and HI Resource Centers, the University of Washington, Alaska think groups, and the University of North Dakota yielded data about service usage and future usage.

This table represents the tribal aggregated responses by percentages and represents 298 Native Indigenous Nations from 119 service units, and over 14,000 elders (55 years and older) across the continental U.S., Alaska and Hawaii. Data was collected during 2007- 2008 by Native community members. Survey processing was completed by the NRCNAA and mailed back to each participating tribal entity (the Native communities have ownership of their results).


