

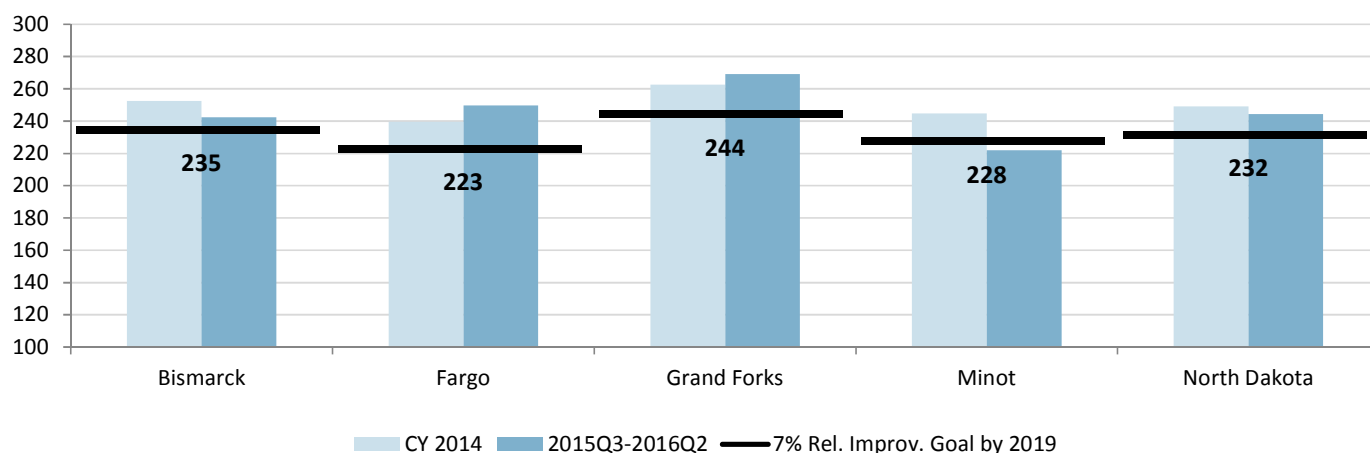
# North Dakota Care Coordination Progress Report - April 2017



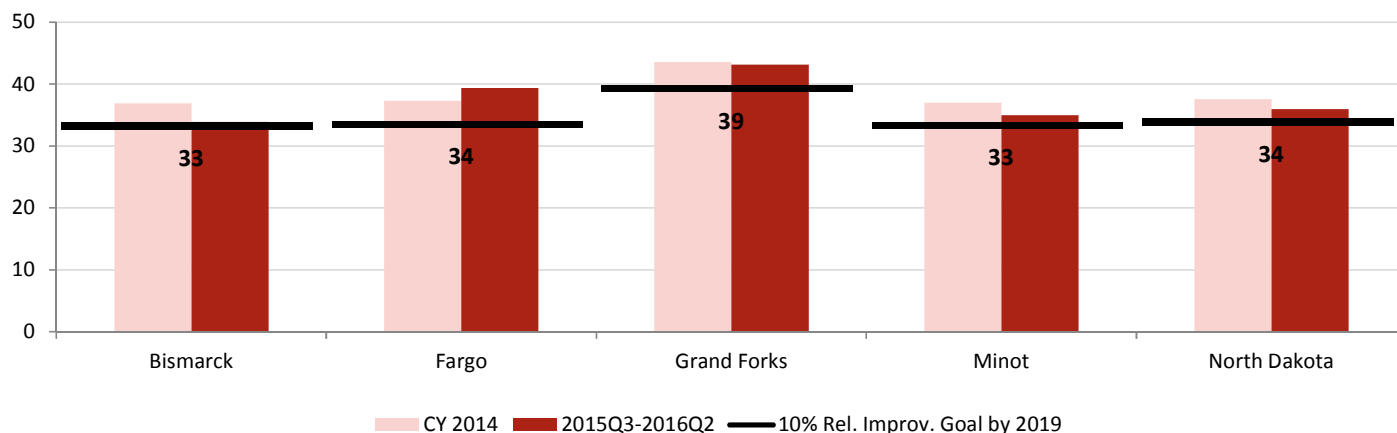
## Background

Communities across the Great Plains Quality Innovation Network (QIN) region are collaborating to improve care coordination. The goal of the communities is to achieve at least 7% relative improvement in avoidable hospital admissions and at least 10% relative improvement in avoidable readmissions between 2014 (baseline) and 2019 (remeasurement). As a partner in the Great Plains QIN, Quality Health Associates of North Dakota is complementing these efforts by sharing data reflecting each community's progress toward achieving these goals.
