## Economic Impact

A strong healthcare system helps attract and maintain local business and industrial growth. It also attracts and retains retirees. The Jacobson Memorial Hospital Care Center and Clinic (JMHCC) creates jobs and contributes to the economy throughout Grant County. Our employees support the area businesses, and our presence brings in dollars to the local economy.

JMHCC is the largest charitable organization and employer in the Elgin area. The hospital operates 30 licensed beds and two rural health clinics in Elgin and Glen Ullin. The hospital and clinics employ 87 people. JMHCC provides comprehensive hospital and clinical services to the residents of Grant County and surrounding areas.

JMHCC contributes to the health and wellness of local residents as well as the overall economic strength of Grant County. The hospital and clinics employ local residents who spend money in the area, which in turn generates a secondary economic impact. Increases or decreases in the size of JMHCC affects the medical health and economic health of the area. About every 3 jobs in the medical center creates another job with businesses in the Grant County area.
