NURSING

- For over 100 years, UND has prepared some of the finest nursing graduates in the nation.
- 2023 graduates had a 97% NCLEX first-time pass rate compared to 92% nationwide.
- Home to the only Ph.D. in Nursing, Nurse Anesthesia, and Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner programs in North Dakota.
- Program emphasizes diverse populations and rural communities — two areas where nurses are in high demand.



RAIN EXPANSION

The nationally recognized Recruitment & Retention of American Indians into Nursing (RAIN) program has over 30+ years of proven success in providing support services to American Indian students enrolled in pre-nursing, undergraduate, and graduate nursing.

The program offers support to UND Nursing, Nutrition & Dietetics, and Social Work students and serves as a “home away from home” for American Indian students at UND.



NUTRITION & DIETETICS

- The Accelerated Dietetics program allows students to earn a bachelor’s and a master’s degree in just five years.
- The Master of Science in Nutrition online, part-time program has two specialization tracks: Nutrition Science and Nutrition Education and Counseling.
- UND offers an NBHWC-approved Health & Wellness Coaching training program and graduate certificate for students from any discipline.
