



# State Health Improvement Plan (SHIP) Defines elements essential toward making progress toward our vision

A SHIP is a long-term, systematic effort to address public health problems.



Use data and community input to identify priority issues.



Develop and implement strategies for action with a focus on system changes and collaboration with partners and communities.



Establish accountability to ensure measurable health improvement.

Priorities and focus areas

#### **Strengthening Workforce**

- Implement effective recruitment, retention and training strategies.
- Ensure a strong and stable workforce.

### **Cultivating Wellness**

- Strengthen childhood opportunities; reduce adverse childhood experiences.
- Decrease occupational injuries.
- Curb tobacco and e-cigarette use.
- Enhance the length and quality of life of tribal populations and older adults.
- Improve health outcomes.

#### **Expanding Access and Connection**

- Expand access to essential healthcare services such as primary care, cardiac care, oral health care, cancer screening, and chronic disease management and prevention.
- Connect individuals to referrals for services and programs that support their holistic wellbeing.

#### **Building Community Resilience**

- Build capacity and enhance readiness for infectious disease response and emergency preparedness and response.
- Strengthen community resilience while being responsive to the challenges of rural communities.

# **Statewide Health Strategies Funding**




- Sixty-eighth Legislative Assembly of North Dakota
- In Regular Session Commencing Tuesday, January 3, 2023
- HOUSE BILL NO. 1004
- SECTION 13.
- STATEWIDE HEALTH STRATEGIES. The sum of \$3,000,000, of which \$1,500,000 is from the community health trust fund and \$1,500,000 is from other income derived from matching funds, appropriated for statewide health strategies in section 1 of chapter 32 of the 2021 Session Laws, is not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11.
