- Where?** Devils Lake, North Dakota (drop off/pick up at Lake Region State College)
- Cost?** \$ 350 (includes meals, lodging, during-camp transportation, activity fees, shirts, backpack, and more)
- Why?** To learn what healthcare professionals do in FUN and INTERACTIVE ways!
- Who?** Any North Dakota student who has completed 9th, 10th or 11th grade as of June 2024, space is limited to 20 students.

Scrubs Academy II is a four-day/three-night camp where high school students learn what it is like to be a health professional and see an array of healthcare professions that they may consider as a career. Students spend their days in various health facilities (Critical Access Hospitals, tertiaries, clinics, long term care and assisted living facilities, ambulances, treatment centers), enjoy fun activities in the evenings, and spend the night in the Lake Region State College dorms. Students have the opportunity to job shadow multiple professions during the course of the camp.
